

The president stated that the GSA scholarship was already approved with the following stipulations. The president emphasized that these stipulations were based on the previous discussion by the council.

- \$1,000 award for students enrolled in a degree program
- \$750 award for students enrolled in a diploma program
- \$500 award for students enrolled in a certificate program

Donor: Concordia University of Edmonton Graduate Students Association

- Must be enrolled in a degree program, diploma program or a certificate
- program at the graduate level
- Must be registered full-time (minimum 60% of a full course load at the time of
- application
- Must have completed one semester at time of application
- Must present a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3
- Demonstrates character and resourcefulness through participation in extracurricular
- activities and/or community involvement

Applications will be accepted once per calendar year with the deadline being February 1st. Most graduate programs have a fall and winter intake but graduate certificate program students who start their program in January and complete their program by December of the same calendar year may not be eligible to apply for the award.

Value of award: \$500 Number of Awards: Two

Two \$500 awards to students enrolled in a degree program, diploma program or a certificate program at the graduate level. Recipients must be registered in a minimum 60% of a full-course load, have achieved satisfactory academic standing for their program and demonstrate financial need. The recipient must not be receiving financial support from their employer or sponsorship to undertake their program of study.

Other Issues
